The WordPress for Websites Online Course will take students through the features of the WordPress software and the steps you need to create your own website from scratch or to maintain an existing website in house. When you have completed the WordPress for websites online course, you will be able to create a WordPress website with blog. You will think about designing a user friendly website (colours, images, accessibility); you will install a template, include plugins, create static pages, include images, use widgets and implement SEO. You will also create blog posts, include Google Analytics in the website and you will receive an introduction to using Google Analytics to measure the success of your site. The course covers everything you need to create a website including information about choice of colours and images, the layout of the website, choosing a template, using plugins and creating static pages. The course includes an introduction to search engine optimisation so right from the start you will create a website that can be found by the search engines and your customers.

The course is delivered through the Distance Learning Centre's new on-line training portal, which is accessed via a web browser such as Internet Explorer, Firefox, Chrome, or Safari. Throughout the course students are supported by a personal course tutor who can give feedback on your work at any time throughout your study.

Learning Object 3: Enhancing Your WordPress Website

This unit contains the following topics: Using plugins and widgets, creating menus and an introduction to HTML. How to get your website found.

Prerequisites:

There are no particular entry requirements, although it is recommended that students have a good understanding of using computers.
